Polymeric Systems moves to new, considerably expanded corporate headquarters

In moving, PSI joins its sister company, Whitford Worldwide, which moved in November of last year.

PSI will offer a new, fully integrated epoxy line, which will expand capacity by 50 percent. It will also have additional mixing capabilities with brand new equipment. There are five times as many truck bays, with convenient road access, to make shipping and receiving easier and faster. Plus dramatically expanded laboratory facilities to accelerate the design of the next generation of adhesives and sealants, and an upgraded computer system to process and deliver orders more quickly.

Said David P. Willis, Jr., president of Whitford, "The new facility is first-class — and provides room for expansion for many years to come." Added Debra Parkes, general manager of PSI, "This finally lets us integrate fully into Whitford, something we've wanted to do ever since we joined the family in 2004."
